It wasn't just another camp; it was an incredible life-changing camp! As one staff person said, "Every year, just when I think 'how will God outdo last year's camp?' He does it again!" With our largest camp yet, over 145 camper and staff gathered for five days of inspiration and perspiration!

Our theme was "EVERY" - "All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with EVERY spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ." (Ephesians 1:3) Jesus Christ sacrificed His life for EVERYone. In EVERY way of your life, on and off your field of play, He is with you. He protects you. He will never leave you. EVERY day, the King of Kings calls you to the highest honor: a relationship with Him. He equips you with EVERY piece of His armor. What is the price tag of this priceless camp? \$56,000.

Most of our camp expenses are covered in camper fees and the funding we raise at our annual Golf Scramble, but not all of it. To cover all expenses, and make sure we do all we can to provide a place where kids can grow in their faith and have a life-changing experience, we raise an extra \$16,000. Praise God, as 18 individuals, churches, and businesses helped us meet our goal! Thank you!
