I had announced that our older daughter, Carolyn Ann, had been suffering from a cancerous tumor in her colon and was to have an operation on the 8th of October. It was removed, but for a few days she had much pain, so they went back in and cleaned some "Junk" out of her system. She is trying to recover and finally is walking and eating some the last few days, but then she still had some discomfort, so yesterday she had a CT scan. It is very hard to give many details but we are thankful that God is in control of everything and that she is recovering.

Noah and Selah are at home with friends almost nightly visiting to keep them busy. Noah has a part time job with a long-time friend and today another friend took them to the Chick-fil-A in Harlingen, for lunch, then Noah drove a couple of miles to work and the friend, Lana, brought Selah to our house until Noah picks her up after 5pm.

Carol is in the big Anderson hospital in Houston, so while Selah is here, I called and had her talk to her and Steve as he was there, having arrived by shuttle between the hospital and hotel. It all has been a great ordeal and Carol has had more pain at different times, but we are trusting in the Lord for complete healing.

In order to get this in the mail, I can only say that she was awaiting her latest CAT scan results, (never any cats around), which was on the 18th. But now to add to the final part of this letter, I have waited until today, the 19th, so I could give the results. The CT scan showed a very small spot of infection which has now been drained and she is feeling so much better. Steve is waiting for her to return to her room and possibly be released by Friday. Now we just have the pleasure of **PRAISING THE LORD!! He is so loving, merciful, and kind, and we just praise Him day and night. "The Lord is my Shepherd; I shall not want, (any good thing)", Psalm 23:1. Praise the Lord!!**
