We as a family are thrilled to introduce Emma Olivia. Emma arrived on Monday, August 15th. She is a gift from Jesus, and we are all enchanted by her.



Thank you for all your prayers for Emma and Eszti; they were heard! As a result of Emma turning breech at 38 weeks Eszti had to have a C-section during which she lost a large amount of blood. Despite this she recovered well and was discharged from the hospital on Thursday. It was extremely special to be home as a family of six, but Friday right before bed Eszti started to exhibit some of the warning signs that she was told to watch out for when she was discharged. After calling the care team she was instructed to go to the hospital. After running tests for the duration of the night, the doctors discovered that she had a small pulmonary embolism! She was readmitted to the hospital and immediately started on blood thinners. We are so thankful that this potentially life threatening complication was discovered and the appropriate treatment was given. After being monitored for the weekend on the new medicine, Eszti was discharged Sunday evening. She will have to be taking blood thinners for the coming months and is still feeling weak and at times dizzy (likely a result of the loss of blood and blood thinners). Thank you for praying even when you didn't know what you were praying for; Jesus knows!
