These past two months have been filled with great joy as we have become a family of six and gotten to know our sweet, little girl. The boys all love having a little sister.


Some of you will remember that Eszti developed pulmonary embolism 5 days after the C-section. As an ongoing treatment she has to inject herself twice daily with blood thinners, but developing other clots remains a serious risk for the time being. Air travel of any sort increases the risk of clots with a long international flight being that much more dangerous. **Therefore, Eszti was not medically cleared to travel back to Hungary at our original planned time; instead, we will be returning to Hungary just before Christmas** (this gives her body a long enough time to have dealt with the clots). We see God's hand of protection in this, as at the end of September Eszti had another clot develop in her arm.

In the meantime, Eszti is back in school continuing the work on her Masters in Mental Health Counseling. These extra months in the US allow her to get in person credit for this semester, which will help with the ultimate completion of her degree.

Additionally, we have the joy of continuing to share about what is happening in Hungary. We would love to connect with you, if we haven't had the chance to yet. While our ability to travel is limited, we would love to schedule a time to meet up over zoom or some other way.

We have been humbled and encouraged by your continued generosity as we have come a long way towards meeting our full need for ongoing financial support.
