

1. If you can spare the time, you may ride along to the appointment and back to the nursing home. The VA. provides a Black and White cab. Arrive at Whitehouse Country Manor 11239 Waterville Rd. in Whitehouse (Archbold Whitehouse Road) one hour and 15 minutes before his appointment time. You will be back about an hour after his appointment.
2. Or drive to the Veteran’s Medical Center at 1200 South Detroit Avenue in Toledo to take him home after his appointment.
