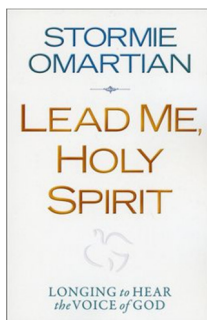


Wednesday Night Ministries is looking for “a few good” people.
