When Sherry and I began to spend spare Autumn afternoons driving around "leaf looking," our kids concluded that we were hopelessly old and over the hill.

October is harvest month. As I drive through the country, I see the crops changing colors and drying out. Soon they will be ripe for harvest, combines will be churning, and farmers all around will be gathering them in.

Was it during October when Jesus made this tour of Palestine? According to Matthew, "When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.'" (9:36-38)

With me, your mind drifts to family members, friends, neighbors, classmates, and co-workers who are harassed and helpless in the face of life events. Some of them are struggles that have been foist upon them; some are struggles of their own making. But they do look like sheep without a shepherd. If only they could be part of a flock. If only they could have a stronger relationship with the Good Shepherd.

You think, "Chapel is a good spot for them. They could find a supportive church family here. They could find a stronger relationship with Jesus here. They could be to the next level on their spiritual journey here. I wish someone would invite them."


Then your mind drifts to "the harvest is plentiful; the workers are few" comment. You wish that these people could be part of God's harvest. If only there were workers to gather them in.

Now I don't know how your mind works, but if it works anything like mine as we meditate on this Scripture passage, you are praying that the Lord of the harvest would send some workers into his harvest field. And all of a sudden, you feel this gentle arm on your shoulder. The Lord of the harvest, Jesus, has his arm around you. He looks you in the eye with his soft, sparkling eye, and says, "I send you."

I love October. I love fall colors. I love the sights and sounds and smells of the harvest. And I really love the people that you will be bringing with you to Chapel. I'm praying for you as you reach out in love to the people around you.

It has been a great start to the school year. We started off the year at youth group focusing on Jeremiah 1:7-8. When God calls Jeremiah to be his prophet to the nations, Jeremiah made some excuses. God responded in verse 7... "But the Lord said to me, 'Do not say to 'I am too young.' You must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you and will rescue you,' declares the Lord." There are some pretty incredible teenagers in our church that are making a huge impact on those around them. We challenged the students to commit to going wherever God wants them to go; saying whatever God wants them to say; and doing whatever God wants them to do. Just like Jeremi-ah, they aren't too young, and God is calling them to do incredible things. This verse will be our focus for the year.

This event takes place all across the country (learn more at fieldsoffaith.com). It will be at Wauseon high school from 7-8 pm. The 7th -12th graders will all be joining together for this night as we carpool from the church at 6:15. We should return around 8:30.
