I want to start with a big thank you for all of the different ways you showed me love this past month. The number of people that did something to make me feel valued and loved was greatly appreciated. Thank you for loving me and encouraging me during October. I'm truly blessed to be at this church.

I want to take some time to update you about the ministry going on at The Rock. This year Liberty Center Schools cancelled their LEAP program, leaving The Rock as the only after school program I know of in Liberty Center. Because of this, we have seen a significant increase in attendance this school year. We have averaged about 22 kids per day. These are kids that come in and spend 2 hours with loving, Christian adults and hear the Gospel through these adults' words and actions. We have partnered with LCUMC to be able to have 3 adults there each day so that we can effectively reach the kids. We have probably had 15 new kids this year that had never been to The Rock before. We are reaching kids and doing effective ministry. More than ever, we need to seize this opportunity to continue reaching more and more kids for Christ. Thank you so much for your support, and please continue to support this awesome ministry through snacks, your time, and most importantly prayer.

In regards to youth, there will be no Wednesday Night Ministries on November 22nd because of Thanksgiving. The youth have a couple of events going on in November. On the 12th, we are going to be eating lunch after church and going out to serve. The tentative plan (based on how many leaves fall) is to do a rake and run (this is NOT a fundraiser). If you know of anybody that could use a little extra help raking their leaves, please let me know. We will also be attending Big Church Night Out, a Christian concert in Toledo on November 17th. We tentatively have a YF Thanksgiving meal planned for November 26th as well. I look forward to another exciting month of ministry.


