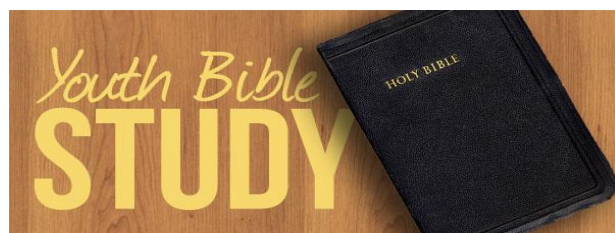

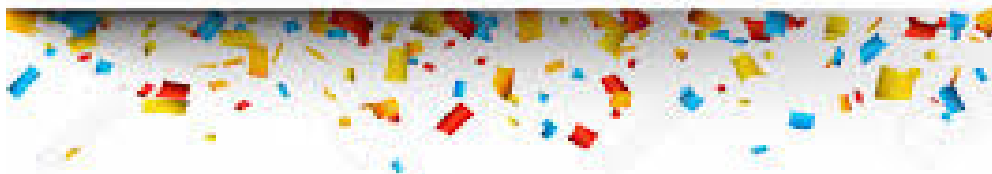
Sr. High students have a Bible study every Monday night at 7 pm. Join us as we dive into God's word over the summer!!! See Marci Nash for the location each week.
