After a long, cold spell, I enjoy a sunny day that feels relatively warm, but March weather is a fickle thing on which to hang your hope. I appreciate good news, vaccinations, and herd immunity, but while I trust the science. I am not sure which scientists to trust.

There is one who is always trustworthy. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." (Proverbs 3:5-6–ESV) I put my trust in God.

Every Sunday, I pray that our worship will praise and glorify Jesus and that our time together will be a spiritual "shot in the arm".

Pray for one another. Pray for healing for those who are ill or hurting. Pray for this virus to end.


