I will continue to lead early worship outside. I expect that we will worship outside all summer and then resurvey early service worshipers. If you are ready to worship inside, you are welcome to do that, and some already do. Eventually, we will move inside, but the radio will remain on. You can worship in the parking lot or on the church grounds at either service on FM 97.5. After some challenging winter weather, I look forward to gathering together in God's great outdoors this summer. Stay in your cars or bring a blanket or chair and worship the Lord.

Online worship will continue to be an option.

We pray that these are good and healthy decisions. Each needs to take personal responsibility for decisions you make regarding church participation.
