All Saints Sunday

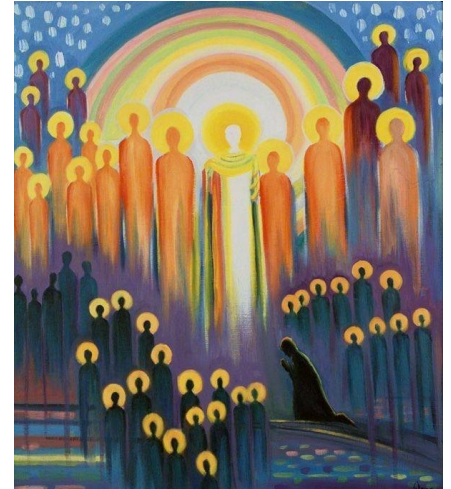

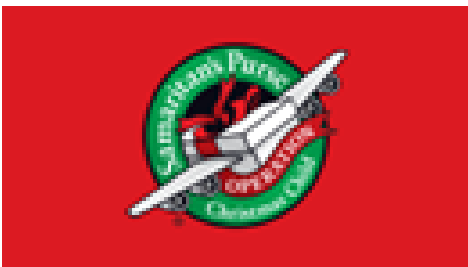
Throw back Sunday is November 7. Outside worship service (8:15 am) will move back inside.
