## Spring Is Springing

"Spring begins in 19 days," proclaims today's "The Old Farmer's Almanac". Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent, means six weeks until Easter.

Lent is a season of spiritual preparation for Easter. It lasts for forty days not includingSundays. The word "Lent" is derived from "lencten"-the Old English word for spring. The word is related to the lengthening of days. Spring is springing. As I look out the window, the sun shines brightly, the snow is melting, and the earth is warming. While it looks warmer than it really is, the warm week that is forecast will probably infect me with a full-blown case of Spring Fever. I am ready to put my parka and heavy winter clothes away in favor of short sleeves and my jacket. We look forward to flowers blooming, trees budding, birds singing, and nature awakening. We anticipate spring sports and outdoor activities. We can hardly wait to plant seeds and to watch crops and gardens grow. "The heavens declare the glory of God."
