## Option 1: Drive-in/Outside Worship. (8:15 am)

Worship in your car or outside in your parka. Tune your FM radio to 90.5. Our broadcast range is limited, so you need to be on the church property to hear.

#### Option 2: Inside Worship. (10:30 am)

Please observe physically distant seating and wear masks. The family room is available for parents with small children. The TV there will show the service. While we have overflow options, they have not been used . . . yet. You can worship outside in your car—FM 90.5.

# **Option 3: Worship online Live or Later.**

The service is live streamed at 10:30 am.
